**Re:** Opening Sealed Bids for K-9 Police Dog and Equipment

On January 22, 2019, at 2:00 p.m., sealed bids were opened by the City Clerk for the sale of the Douglas Police K-9 Dual Purpose Dog and equipment. A total of two (2) bids were received as follows:

1. **Big Horn County Sheriff's Department:** \$901.00 with removal within seven (7) days of receipt of notification of successful bid;
2. **Amber Peterson:** \$1,000.00 with removal via personally picking up the dog from Douglas Police Department.

It is my recommendation to accept the high bid of \$1,000.00 from Amber Peterson. Amber works for the Converse County Sherriff's Office and was the K-9 handler when she was employed with the City of Douglas. I'm hopeful that the K-9 can be utilized in the manner for which the City had intended.
