Clerk Rimmer provided an overview of the 94 changes, which incorporate changes that will go into effect as

95 of July 1, 2019, as a result of approved legislation, 96 specifically House Bill 0076, House Bill 0219, House Bill 0212, 97 Senate File 0113, and Senate File 0140. No further discussion 98 and motion approve 4-0.
