

**RESOLUTION NO. 2073**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RELIANT FEDERAL CREDIT UNION TO INSTALL AN ELECTRONIC MESSAGE BOARD SIGN IN AN R-3 LIMITED MIXED RESIDENTIAL ZONE AT 239 SOUTH 4<sup>TH</sup> STREET (ORIGINAL TOWN OF DOUGLAS, BLOCK 20, LOTS 8, 9, AND PART OF 10), CITY OF DOUGLAS**

**WHEREAS**, Reliant Federal Credit Union wishes to install an electronic message board sign at 239 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the message board sign would be utilized to provide information regarding products and services provided by the Reliant Federal Credit Union, as well as special events and time and temperature; and

**WHEREAS**, the Douglas Municipal Code requires the proposed use obtain prior approval by the City Council as part of the conditional use permit review and approval process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Department staff and the Douglas Planning and Zoning Commission have reviewed the application to ensure that it shall have no adverse impact upon the welfare of the public, and the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval to the Douglas City Council following a public hearing on January 18, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the following conditions are recommended by City staff and the Planning and Zoning Commission, as stated in the Unified Land Development Code of the Douglas Municipal Code:

1. The sign may not exceed the proposed 32.2 square feet for the electronic message display.
2. Each message on an electronic message display shall be displayed for at least four (4) to eight (8) seconds.
3. The transition between messages display shall be instantaneous. Transitional effects shall be limited to instant (slideshow), fade, dissolve, circle out, diamond out, jaws, zoom, wipe left, wipe right, scroll, and travel.
4. The electronic message display shall be equipped with technology that automatically dims the electronic message displays according to ambient light conditions to a luminance or nighttime brightness level of up to five hundred (500) NIT, which will result in a reduction of display brightness between five (5) percent and twenty-five (25) percent, depending on the resolution of the sign. Documentation shall be provided from the sign manufacturer which verifies compliance with auto dimming and brightness requirements.
5. The electronic message display shall be equipped with the ability to be shut off within twenty-four (24) hours of malfunctioning. Signs under repair shall be shut off.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, WYOMING**, that Reliant Federal Credit Union is granted a conditional use permit to install an electronic message board sign at 239 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street (Original Town of Douglas, Block 20, Lots 8, 9, and part of 10), contingent upon the adherence to the above conditions placed upon the permit by the City Council.
