Communications Officer Sonya Parker maintained open communication and guidance with the caller and emergency services. While emergency services were enroute, it was further reported that the child had stopped breathing and was turning blue. Communications Officer Parker held her composure and provided proper guidance to the caller, later learned to be the mother of the child. Officer Adam Reiter arrived on scene and found the child not breathing. Officer Reiter immediately started Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), thus saving the life of the child.
