Recommendations

Consider approving slurry sealing bid for FY 2022-2023.

Executive Summary

Bids were sought for slurry sealing of 166,660 sq yds of asphalt though out different locations around town and including north 2nd & 3rd St for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.

Only one bid was received from Asphalt Preservation L.L.P. in the amount of \$388,317.80 at a rate of \$2.33/yard for the slurry, plus traffic control at \$7,500 and mobilization at \$15,000, for a total bid amount of \$410,817.80. This is well under the budgeted amount of \$500,000.

As a side not, Asphalt Preservation L.L.P is also the same firm that did the City's previous bid.

In addition, staff has been in contact with Asphalt Preservation L.L.P and the company indicated that they would make Douglas' 2nd and 3rd Streets a priority and could possibly be in the community to do the downtown slurry work in early September.
