Consider signing cooperative agreement with WYDOT for replacing the Antelope bridge on 2nd. St.

Executive Summary

The federal government has approved \$250 million for the replacement of bridges in Wyoming. SLIB is in charge of this funding and has directed WYDOT to allocate \$25 million each year for the next 5 years. WYDOT has recognized 29 bridges in Wyoming that are in dire need of replacement. The bridge on 2nd St. is one of the 29.

This program is 100% funded through SLIB.

WYDOT is ready to survey the bridge and start the design. This project is slated for 2025 but could be pushed up depending on weather the bridge will be replaced or the installation of box culverts.
