Executive Summary

On December 21, 2019, President Trump signed H.R. 1865 which increased the minimum age to purchase tobacco products from 18 to 21. Wyoming followed and Governor Gordon signed SF 50 which also increased the minimum age to purchase tobacco products from 18 to 21. This ordinance is in line with federal and state law and addresses penalties associated with violation of ordinance.

Update for 2nd Reading: The City of Douglas is required to, at a minimum, meet State Statute. The City can be more stringent than the State, but cannot be less Stringent.
