

## ORDINANCE NO. 1018

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 10.92.070, 10.04.010(xxxix), 10.52.010(a)(i)(E) AND 10.52.040 AND CREATING 10.48.080 PERTAINING TO THE PARKING OF TRUCKS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Douglas (City) Council finds and determines that the following changes and clarifications need to be made in regard to the City of Douglas Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, consideration has been given to ensure fairness to all City of Douglas residents and make new regulations reasonable.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DOUGLAS, WYOMING:**

**Section 1.** Section 10.92.070 of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.92.070 Truck Parking.**

- (a) No person shall park any commercial truck over ten thousand (10,000) pounds gross vehicle weight upon any street or alley in the city except in those areas designated as either business or industrial.  
Exception: Commercial trucks may be parked on the west side of Brownfield Road between the entrance to the Wyoming State Fair Grounds and South property line of the Wyoming State Fair Grounds.
- (b) No person shall park any commercial truck of any type loaded with L.P. gas, explosives, livestock, petroleum products, or radioactive material, on any street or alley in the city, except when in the process of loading or unloading.
- (c) No person shall park any livestock truck or trailer upon any street.
- ~~(a)~~(d) No person shall park any commercial truck of any type within fifteen feet of an access or driveway.
- ~~(b)~~(e) The chief of police may cause any truck, as described in subsection B of this section, to be towed to such a place as is determined safe as if such truck is left unattended or parked in violation of subsection B. Any and all fees for such towing shall be the responsibility of the driver and/or owner of the truck.
- ~~(e)~~(f) Truck parking shall comply with the requirements of Section 5.8.3 of the Unified Land Development Code.

**Section 2.** Section 10.04.010(xxxix) of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.04.010 – Section 31-5-102 Definitions.**

- (xxxix) "Safety zone" means the area or space officially set apart within a roadway for the exclusive use of pedestrians and which is protected or is so marked or indicated by adequate signs as to be plainly visible at all times while set apart as a safety zone. Any curb officially marked in reflective yellow shall be considered a safety zone.

**Section 3.** Section 10.52.010(a)(i)(E) of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.52.010 Section 31-5-504 – Specific places where prohibited.**

Between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within ~~thirty-fifteen~~ (30)15 feet of points on the curb immediately opposite the ends of a safety zone, unless a different length is indicated by signs or markings;

**Section 4.** Section 10.52.040 of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

**10.52.040 Parking of trucks prohibited on certain streets.**

There shall be no parking of trucks of any kind on North Third Street between Walnut Street and Center Street or on the east side of Brownfield Road. For purposes of this section, "truck" shall not include vehicles of one (1) ton or under.

**Section 5.** Section 10.48.080 of the Douglas Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

Semi-truck trailers not connected to a tractor shall not be parked on any street for any amount of time.
