Agreement with Converse County regarding Olds Road at Landfill

Recommendation

Approve agreement with Converse County

Executive Summary

This agreement will establish the payment of \$500,000 from Converse County to the City of Douglas as monetary remuneration for the City’s agreement to assume the ownership of Olds Road leading to the landfill as well as to assume the upkeep, repairs, and responsibilities of the same.

Background

For the past several months, City and County officials have been discussing the possibility of establishing an agreement in light of the lack of clarity of responsibility and ownership of Olds Road. These discussions culminated the City submitting to the County on June 19, 2023, a proposal for the County to reconstruct the 2600’ length of 35’ wide road at an estimated cost of \$1.3M. The County later that same day, counteroffered the proposal for the County to pay the City \$500,000 and the City assume the reconstruction of the road as it saw fit. The City Council agreed to these terms at its Worksession on June 26.
