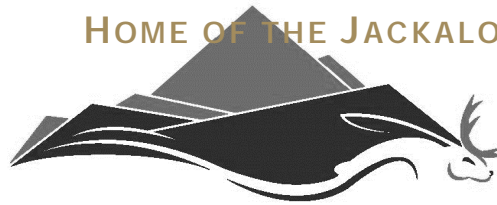

Re: Police Department Report – July 2023

Officer Howard graduated the Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy (WLEA) on July 20, 2023, and is working day shift.

Officer Knight and Red have completed multiple narcotics searches this past month along with several public relations events and demonstrations. Two felony level arrests with a total of 2g methamphetamine are a result. (KPI ASC-05)

Several more businesses have been added to our new business alliance program (KPI ASC-03).

One of the new patrol cars budgeted 2022 has arrived and is in Casper waiting to be upfitted.

We have been working on a peer-support program (KPI ASC-07), and the policy is complete. We are in hopes to have this policy to council for approval on the August 28, 2023, council meeting.

We have been working with Shaina Smith (Smith Psychological) to implement a program which provides officers, and civilian staff, an annual “wellness visit”, which assist personnel in identifying potential issues such as burn-out, compassion fatigue, and secondary trauma. This agency has had several related employee mental health related issues over the course of the last three years. Our goal is to maintain a mentally healthy environment for all Police Department Employees to work. The cost of this would be covered under our current Employee Assistance Program administered under POST and Associates. We are looking at the second full week of September. Our current policy will be amended and to council for approval on the August 28 council meeting.

Officer Byler attended the Blood Spatter Analysis Training in Casper the week of August 7, 2023.

Officer Boonstra and Byerly attended Crime Scene Training.

We are preparing for the Wyoming State Fair and Parade which begins this week. We will once again have our Command Trailer down at the fairgrounds by the Rotary booth. Converse County Joint Communications will be sharing the command trailer with the Police Department this year.
