Consideration of Ordinance 13.04.110 defining Curb Stop Installation and Access.

Executive Summary

To define that no person will tamper with or destroy water shut off, and also to provide the City with the ability to remove vehicles parked on curb stops, so that they can be accessible for City purposes, including emergencies, non-pay or all general purpose.

Background

In past history there have been multiple cases of vehicles parked on curb stops and the City was unable to shut off for non-pay or emergencies. Additional difficulties occurred when the curb stops were filled with debris or customers turned their own water back on.
